IS AN AIRBNB GUEST A SUB-TENANT?

There has been some recent press over the VCAT decision in *Swan v Uecker* (Residential Tenancies) [2016] VCAT 483 which has now been appealed. In this case, a residential tenant put the leased property on Airbnb without the landlord's consent. The landlord then served a notice to vacate on the basis that the tenant had wrongly sub-let the property. It appears that the outcome of the appeal will be significant.
